Warped comes from the Old English weorpan, meaning "to throw" or "to twist," rooted in the Proto-Indo-European verb for bending or turning from the straight. In weaving, the warp is the set of vertical threads held under tension as the base of a fabric — the structure onto which the weft is woven. To be warped can mean both "shaped by the threads of tradition" and "distorted, twisted, reimagined." This title reflects our vision: taking the strong verticals of heritage and pulling them in unexpected directions, bending the familiar into radical new forms.
